In the event of inclement weather (e.g., severe storms, temperature extremes), we reserve the right to close the facility at any time and, under those circumstances, request our riders to call prior to driving to the farm.

In recognition of the inherent dangers associated with riding, we must request that a release from liability form be signed by the rider, or the parent or legal guardian if the rider is a minor child, prior to participation in any riding activity at the farm. We appreciate your understanding.
